BLACKWATER CREEK FLOOD WALL

The wall has been installed as per plan on the westerly side of North End Blvd. The Pump station is complete and the road drainage system is currently underway. The roads in the vicinity are being prepared for repaving. I'm told by Highway Director Don Levesque that the majority of the roads will be completed before the bad weather arrives, and that all roads in that area (if not

paved) will be, at least, ready for winter, with completion in spring.

The wall was tested during a big high tide with a full moon. I'm happy to report that the wall did hold back the water from the street with a few minor glitches, (IE: Caulking). And the reports from the neighborhood are positive. FINALLY, we put a close on a long awaited project.

CENTRAL AVENUE REPAIRS

I have been in discussion with DPW Director Don Levesque about the progress of the sewer repairs and subsequent road repairs on Central Avenue. The funding is in place and available for sewer repairs. When the repairs are complete the town could prepare to re-pave the road and sidewalks. On November 1st, Don assured me that it is on his top priority list. We will continue to monitor this project.





BOARDWALK ON OCEAN FRONT SOUTH

The Boardwalk design has been completed by architects. The Boardwalk Committee approved the plans and the advertisements for bids were published. There were quite a few potential contractors walking through the area, which in turn provided a wide variety of bids.... the more the better. The deadline for bidding has ended and a review of the contractors is in progress. This is now "a ready to go" project. Once a contract is signed, the project should start sometime in November, with a completion date of early spring, 2017.

And this boardwalk is just the beginning of a new vision for Salisbury Beach Center. We have to say Thank You to Senator Ives and Representative Kelcourse and town officials for lobbying for and receiving a State Seaport Grant of \$1 Million Dollars for the construction. The boardwalk will have something for all; Handicapped access, seating, shade, lighting, tables and a play area for children, and a spectacular view of our ocean. How Exciting.....
